

INSIDE FISHING RULES: B.O.A.T. CLUB INC.

1. Fish will be weighed in under four separate divisions:
 - Men's
 - Ladies
 - Junior Boy's
 - Junior Girl's
 2. All fish will weighed and measured.If decision cant be made,coin will be tossed.
 3. Comp starts at 5pm friday and finishes sunday 12pm.You do not have to sign in first.You can wiegh in any time you like as long as member witness not family is present.
 4. Should a member leave the event before its conclusion or chooses not to attend the weigh in they MUST ensure the Fishing Captain has been advised (by radio or other means).
 5. Radio frequency for all events will be 27.94 mHz.
 6. Conditions concerning cancellation of an event will be by the competitor contacting the Fishing Captain to be sure of the situation. The event cancellation will be broadcast on 27.94 mHz one half hour prior to the official weigh out.
 7. All boats must carry the required safety equipment stipulated by the Department of Harbours and Marine.
 8. Inside fishing is to be conducted within the waters of Moreton Bay and the rivers entering the Bay.
 9. At the Fishing Captains discretion the option of surf fishing will be included which will allow fishing from the waters edge on the ocean side of South Stradbroke Island. The edge is considered from a standing position on the beach not from a boat.
 10. To be eligible to win a championship trophy Members must have attended a minimum of 50% of organised inside fishing trips. **i.e. 3 out of 5.**
 11. Points will be given for the 3 biggest fish of each species that are equal to or exceed the minimum LEGAL LENGTH as set by the QLD Department of Fisheries. Bag limits must also be obeyed and considered per trip. Winter whiting will be a minimum size of 20 cm.
- POINTS ARE ALLOCATED AS FOLLOWS**
- Points will be allocated to each person as follows:
- 1 point for ugliest.(fish that is!)
 - 5 points at the weigh in
 - 10 points for biggest
 - 8 points for second
 - * 6 points for third
12. Outside fishos will depend on weather.If too bad inside rules will apply.
 13. ONLY 3 fish of each species will be wieghed per member and will be measured from nose to end of tail.
