Hi everyone

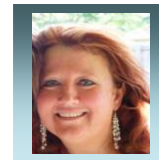

Treasurers Report

Great news from the Treasurers department. A majority of the fees for the financial year remain the same with just a few exceptions.

The dinghy rack fee has risen from \$40 to \$48 per year. The Joining Fee of \$100, Annual Membership fee of \$180, Capital Levy \$80 and Lockers are \$60 remain the same for the 2011-2012 year. There has been one change to the Visitors Fees. A family will now be \$20 per night.

During our last management meeting, the Capital Levy was discussed in relation to pro-rata amounts for new members who may join part way through a year. On a few occasions, it has been noted that prospective members who are interested in joining, especially around the Easter period, prefer to wait until the new financial year to join based on paying the full Capital Levy amount. With this in mind, a decision was made to allow for the levy to be charged as quarterly amounts to new members. If a new member joins in the 2nd quarter of the year, the charge will therefore be \$60 for the Capital Levy and subsequently \$40 for the 3rd quarter and \$20 for the final quarter. It is hoped this will encourage new memberships during the second half of the year. The pro-rata for membership subscription, lockers and dinghy rack hire will be charged monthly as per usual.

With the end of this financial year getting closer, I would like to remind club members the importance of keeping your details up to date. Renewal of your membership for 2011-2012 period will be sent via snail mail to the address we have on file.

How are you going selling the raffle tickets which help to reduce costs associated with our Annual Dinner? Should you require more please contact Rear Commodore Sue Thomas via email or mobile. Sold all your tickets - fabulous - remember to return them with your payment before closing date June 1st 2011.

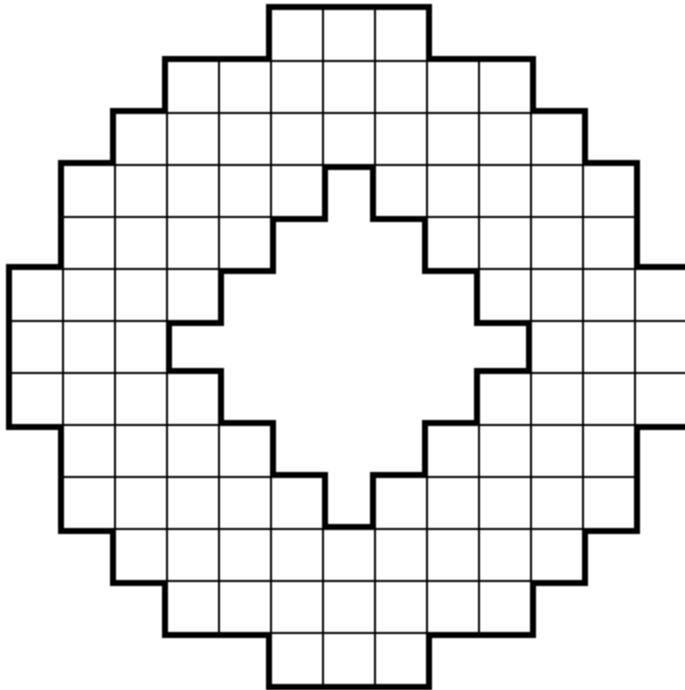

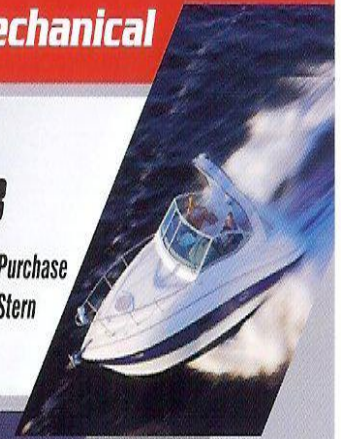

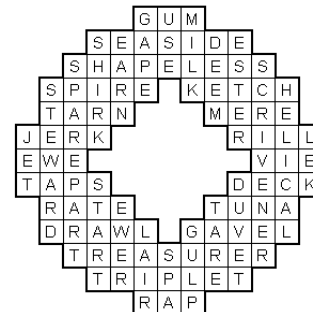
